Q-PARK CS NEW BABYLON

The Hague Conference Centre is located next to the Utrechtsebaan and is easily accessible by car via the connecting highways A4 and A12. From the A12, you can park your car directly at Q-Park CS New Babylon. This parking garage has 1,246 parking spaces available and is open 24/7. With an elevator, you have direct access to the entrance of The Hague Conference Centre.

ACCESSIBILITY

The Q-Park below The Hague Conference Centre has six parking spaces for people with disabilities. There is an elevator to the entrance of the conference center. There are also elevators in the building, as well as accessible toilets for people with disabilities.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

With a direct train connection from Schiphol or Rotterdam The Hague Airport, you can reach The Hague Central Station in just 30 minutes. You can also easily travel to The Hague Conference Centre from Rotterdam The Hague Airport. You can take bus line 33 and transfer to the RandstadRail metro line E at Meijersplein, which will take you directly to The Hague Central Station. Prefer taking a taxi? Even then, you will arrive at The Hague Conference Centre within half an hour.

ORGANIZED TRANSPORTATION

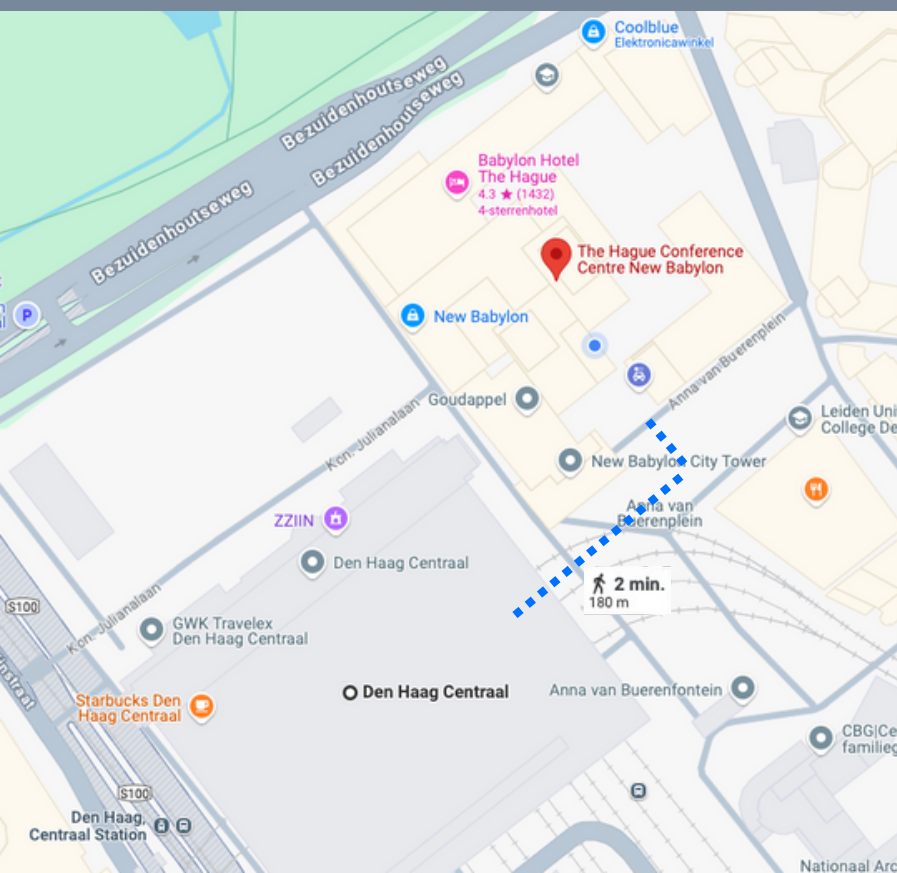
A taxi from Schiphol to The Hague Conference Centre costs approximately 75 euros. From Rotterdam The Hague Airport, a taxi will cost around 40 euros.



PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

THE HAGUE CENTRAL STATION

The Hague Conference Centre is located directly adjacent to The Hague Central Station, making it easily accessible. Upon arrival at the station, follow the signs towards the Koningin Julianaplein exit, and you will come across New Babylon, where The Hague Conference Centre is situated on the 1st and 2nd floor. If you are using public transportation, we recommend planning your journey via NS.nl. The website 9292ov.nl can also provide information on which bus or tram lines to take.



PARKING

CAR PARKING

Underneath The Hague Conference Centre, you will find the Q-Park CS parking garage, with entrances on Prinses Irenestraat and Prins Willem Alexanderweg. It offers 1,248 parking spaces.

BICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES

Near The Hague Central Station, there is a free supervised bicycle parking facility provided by Biesieklette. For an overview of all bicycle parking facilities, click here. There are only charges associated with the facilities if you park your bicycle for longer than one day. Motorcyclists can park at Q-Park. See: parking facilities.
